## LA PORTE COUNTY SHERIFF RELEASES 2020 ANNUAL REPORT AND STATISTICS

La Porte County Sheriff John T. Boyd is announcing the release of the 2020 Annual Report. The 2020 Annual Report contains crime related and statistical information in the following categories: calls for service, information in the areas of offenses, arrests, crashes, citations, the Jail Division, the Warrants Division, and the Civil Division. "This year's annual report year reveals some major reductions in certain areas of major crimes, such as robberies and burglaries. However, just as there were some reductions, there were also increases in certain statistical areas," stated Sheriff Boyd.

The number of calls for service in 2020 decreased by 8%. A total of 28,903 calls for service were handled by deputies of the Sheriff's Office as compared to 31,288 calls for service in 2019. Offenses generating an incident report decreased by 29%. A total of 2,710 offenses were investigated in 2020 as compared to 3,805 in 2019.

Violent crime totals decreased by 4% in 2020. A total of 248 violent crimes were investigated in 2019 as compared to 237 during 2020. There was a 0% change in the number of homicides investigated by the Sheriff's Office from 2019 to 2020, with three (3) being investigated each year. In the area of robbery, there was an 89% reduction (9 vs. 1). Sheriff Boyd stated, "We are very pleased with the sharp reduction in the amount of robberies. Robberies are violent crimes against an individual person that are very traumatic and dangerous," stated Sheriff Boyd.

In 2020, a total of 1,061 subjects were arrested by deputies of the Sheriff's Office. A total of 2,718 traffic citations were issued in 2020. A total of 5,285 traffic warnings were issued to motorists by Sheriff's Office Deputies. Sheriff Boyd stated, "The total amount of citations issued versus the total amount of warnings issued reveals that deputies are using their discretion and applying it to correct the driving behaviors of motorists on all La Porte County roadways."

A total of 1,176 traffic crashes were investigated in 2020, an 8% reduction from the previous year (2019-1,274). Of those, 240 personal injury crashes were investigated in 2020 as compared to 262 personal injury crashes investigated in 2019. Ten (10) fatality crashes were investigated in 2020 by deputies as compared to seven (7) in 2019. Alcohol related crashes investigated by deputies dramatically increased. In 2020, 75 alcohol related crashes were investigated as to compared to 24 in 2019, a 213% increase.

Sheriff Boyd stated, "While we are pleased with the reduction in the overall number of crashes and personal injury crashes, we are concerned about the rise in traffic fatalities and the sharp increase in alcohol related crashes. In 2021, while using a variety of means and resources, patrol deputies will make a concerted effort to reduce traffic fatalities and alcohol related crashes on La Porte County roadways."

The Sheriff's Office continues to pursue and receive federally funded grants from the Indiana Criminal Justice Institute. These grants allow additional deputies to be deployed at no additional cost to the taxpayers. In addition, select deputies are trained and now working the Domestic Highway Enforcement initiative, a program funded by federal monies and administered by Indiana HIDTA.

The La Porte County Jail booked in 3,231 subjects in 2020. The average daily population of inmates confined to the jail was 310. In January of 2020, the Sheriff's Office contracted with and turned over operations of the kitchen to Tiger Correctional Services. A total of 384,495 meals were prepared by the Tiger Kitchen staff.

The Warrants Division processed a total of 2,903 criminal arrest warrants that were issued in 2020. A total of 2,068 criminal arrests warrants were served in 2020.

Transparency with the citizens of La Porte County remains a priority for the Sheriff's Office. The entire annual report, along with the entire Jail Division annual report, will be published on the agency's website: [www.laportecountysheriff.com](http://www.laportecountysheriff.com). Sheriff Boyd added, "The citizens of La Porte County are encouraged to review the reports which provide valuable statistical information. The reports also provide the taxpaying citizens of the county an opportunity to educate themselves as to how their tax dollars are utilized. Both reports highlight the hard work and dedication of the men and women of the Sheriff's Office. The staff of the Sheriff's Office remains committed to improving the safety and quality of life in La Porte County."

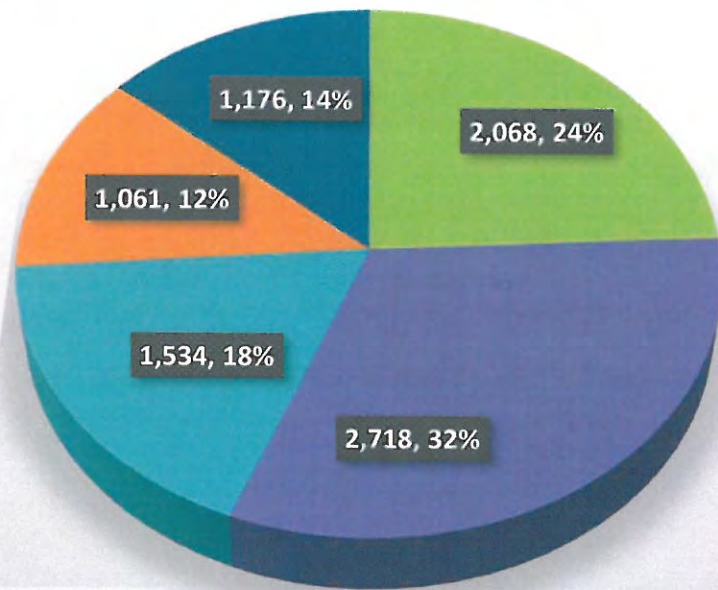

### LA PORTE COUNTY DRUG TASK FORCE RELEASES 2020 STATS

La Porte County, IN, February 16, 2021– The La Porte County Drug Task Force is releasing their yearly statistics and activity report. The La Porte County Drug Task Force, an initiative of Indiana HIDTA (High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area), is a multi-agency unit comprised of investigators from the La Porte County Sheriff's Office, Michigan City Police Department, La Porte City Police Department, and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives (ATF). In their fourth year of existence, the La Porte County Drug Task Force had the following statistics in 2020:

**297 total cases worked**

**95 controlled narcotics purchases**

**129 individuals were arrested**

**12 search warrants were executed**

**62 firearms were seized/purchased through various investigations**

**19 investigations were conducted assisting the partnering agencies detective bureaus**



As a result of these investigations, The La Porte County Drug Task Force has purchased and / or seized the following amounts of narcotics from the streets of La Porte County:

**Cocaine: 597.80 grams (1.31 lbs.)**

**Heroin: 170.20 grams (0.37 lbs.)**

**Methamphetamine: 822.90 grams (1.81 lbs.)**

**Marijuana: 26,597.29 grams (58.63 lbs.)**

*"The La Porte County Drug Task Force continues to aggressively investigate the illegal distribution of narcotics and firearms; while investigating the sources of those drugs and firearms from inside, and outside, of La Porte County. The taskforce has shown great success due to the cooperation with surrounding agencies, as well as the public's assistance. HIDTA's continued support of our unit enables us to efficiently and effectively investigate the illegal distribution of drugs and firearms within our community. Although 2020's operations were impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic, the unit remained successful in disrupting several Drug Trafficking Organizations. A record number of firearms were also seized in 2020. Through the efforts of the detectives assigned to the Task Force in 2020, 62 firearms were seized through various criminal investigations. This number is double of the number of guns seized in both 2017 and 2018 by this Unit. "I am proud of the work and dedication that each investigator puts forth daily to preserve the quality of life within our community", said Lt. Tim Richardson Commander of the La Porte County Drug Task Force.*

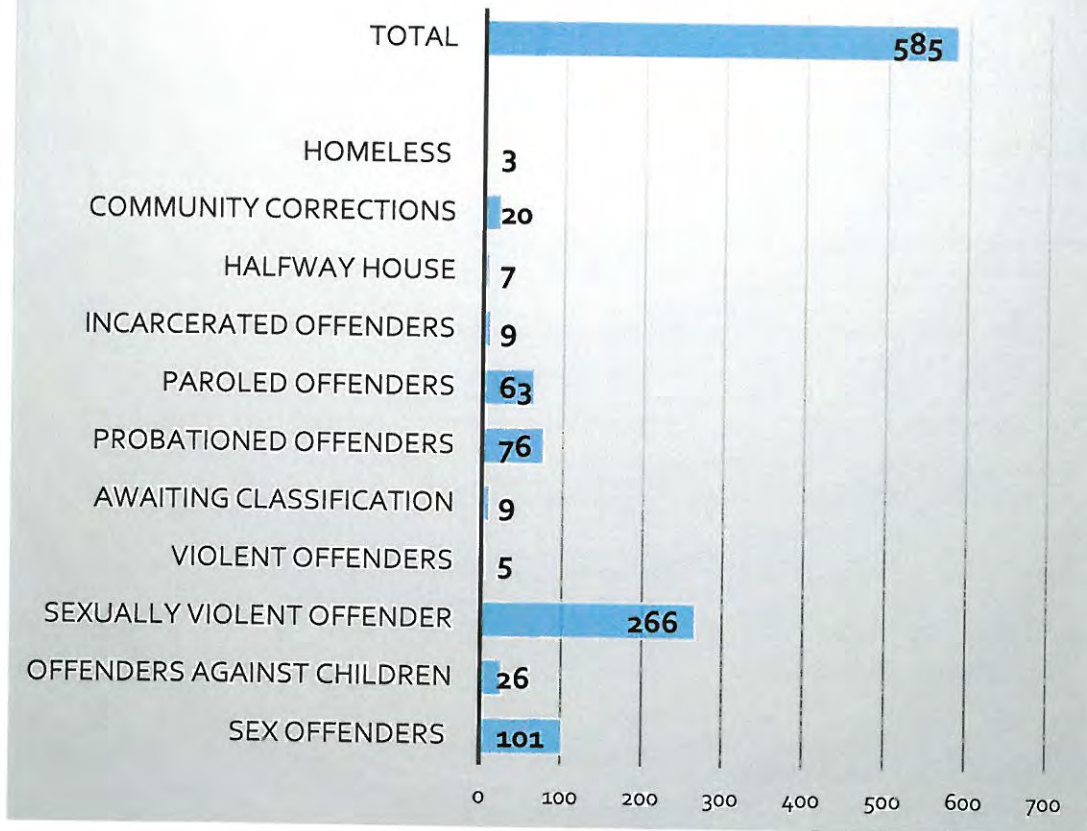

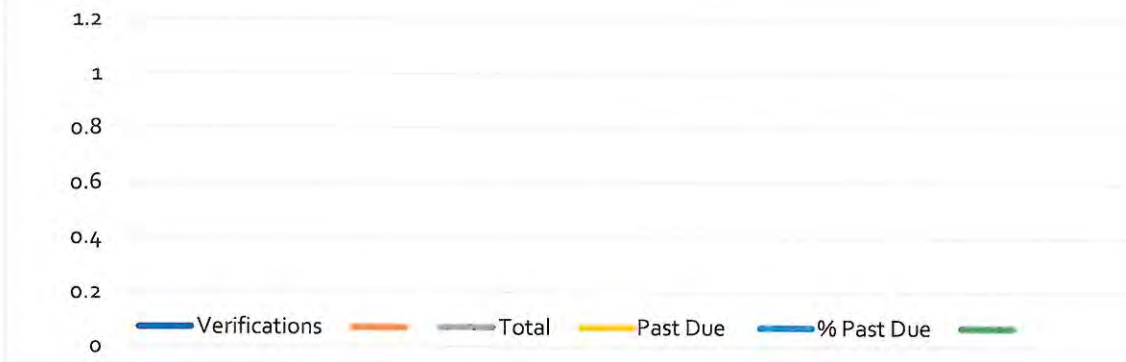

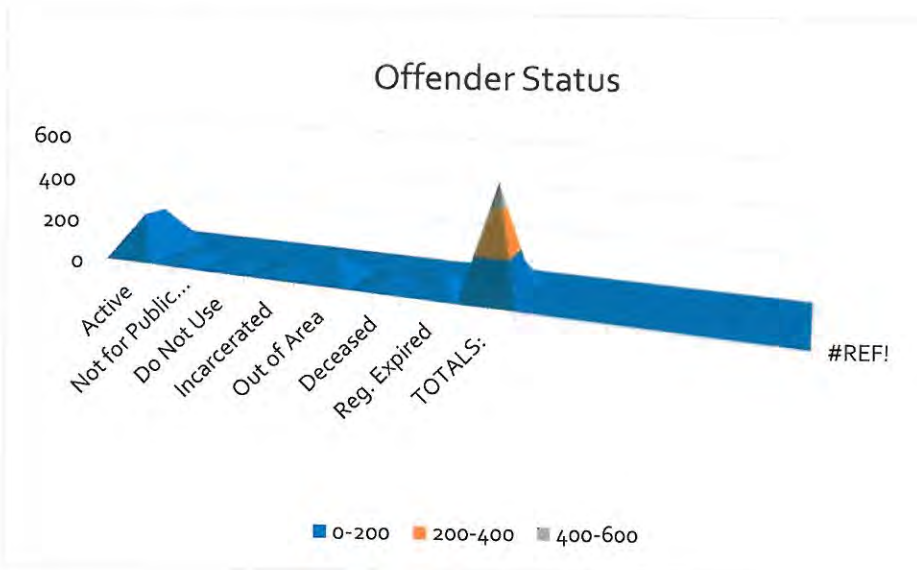

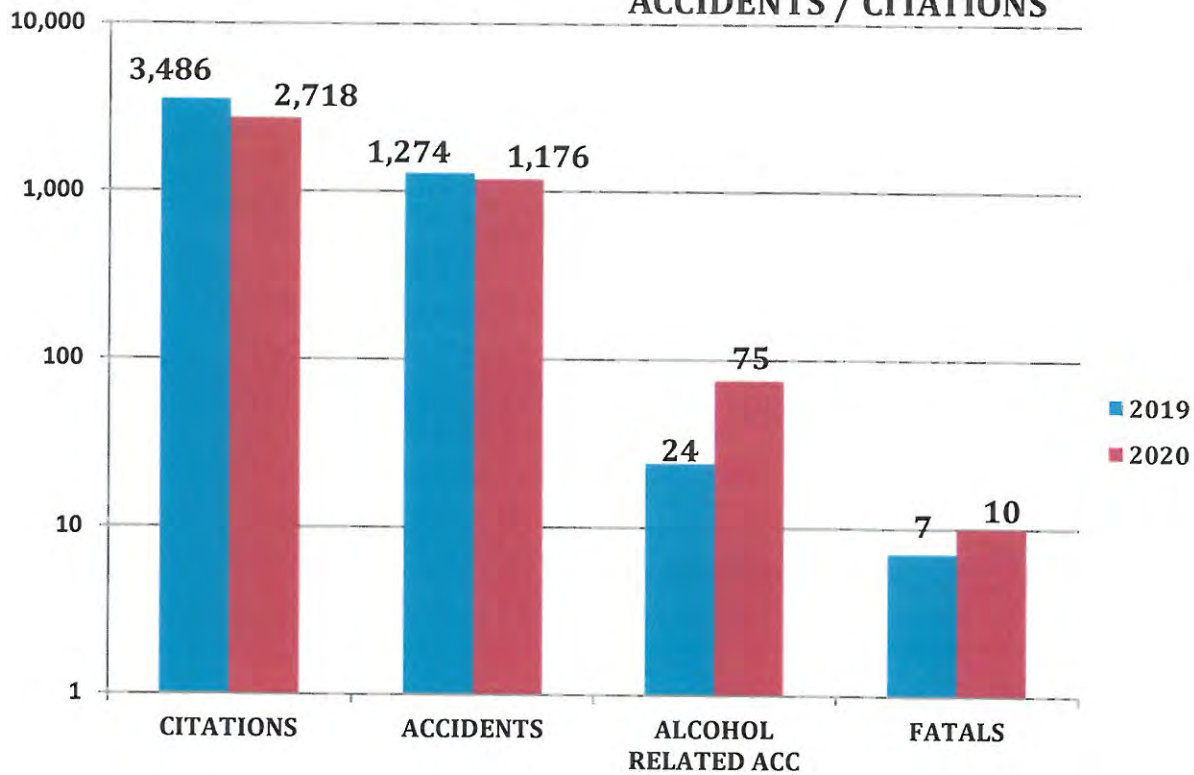

2020 YEAR END REPORT

In 2020 most of the Emergency Response Team (ERT) activations were due to protests and rallies at Indiana Department of Corrections facilities and in the cities of La Porte and Michigan City.

### EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM CALL-OUTS IN 2020

- (1) On March 16 at approximately 2:00 am the Emergency Response Team was summoned to Maple Tree Apartments in the City of La Porte for an armed man who had barricaded himself in an apartment. Crisis Negotiators began to negotiate with the male who was suicidal and because of the protracted nature of the incident and cold weather, the Michigan City Police Department Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT) team was summoned to assist. After more than ten hours of negotiations, the male subsequently exited the apartment and surrendered without incident.
- (2) On May 31 the Emergency Response Team was activated to assist the Michigan City Police Department for a planned protest near their Police Department. The protest was initially mostly peaceful but a large group of people began to gather near the entrance of Lighthouse Place Premium Outlets on Wabash Street. Upon arrival, Team members and deputies were met by a large crowd, some of whom were throwing rocks, golf balls, eggs and bottles. While a number of deputies were struck by these objects, none of the officers or deputies were seriously injured. By midnight most of the crowd had dispersed and the Team was able to stand-down.
- (3) On June 1 the Team was again activated due to threats and concerns of looting in Michigan City. The Michigan City Police Department received tips indicated that "bus loads of people" were being transported to the area and that pallets of bricks had been strategically placed in the City and were to be used to break windows and destroy property. The Michigan City SWAT Team was staged at the Outlet Mall while the Emergency Response Team was



divided and monitored activity in several different business district areas. Fortunately, no large crowds gathered and there was no criminal activity or looting.

- (4) On June 5 the Team was activated for a planned protest at the Circuit Courthouse in La Porte. The Michigan City Police Department SWAT Team worked side-by-side with ERT but the protest was peaceful and neither teams were deployed as no crowd control was needed and there was no criminal activity.
- (5) On October 22 the Emergency Response Team was summoned to the 8600 West block of 200 North for a domestic battery in which a male was reportedly armed and refused to exit the home. Upon arrival of the Team, it was determined that the victims and family members had been separated and were safe and no longer in danger and that the Team was no longer needed.
